The purpose of this qualification is to ensure that individuals performing supervisory functions within a casino have the skills and competencies required to effectively perform their duties. Effective supervision of gaming operations is essential to prevent, inter alia, cheating, fraud and money laundering, all of which are extremely detrimental to profitability and the smooth operation of a casino. It is also necessary to help manage the consequences of problem and pathological gambling, and promote responsible gambling practice.
